Chamberlain, Hrdlicka, White, Williams & Martin partner **Richard N. Hubert's** family trust has given \$5 million to the **Hubert-Yeargan Center for Global Health** at **Duke University**. The center's mission is to improve health practices through teaching and research in developing countries that include Tanzania, Sri Lanka and Thailand.

It was established in 2004 by a \$2.5 million gift from the Hubert Family Trust and a \$4 million gift from the Yeargan Charitable Foundation Trust. The Hubert Family Trust also has endowed a global health program at **Emory University's Rollins School of Public Health** and agricultural partnerships with charitable and faith-based organizations in North Korea and Haiti.
